Scholarship Program

Program Overview

GIRLS GO Engineering! is a scholarship designed for female students pursuing university studies in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM).

Selected students will receive an award of up to 1,500 EUR towards their tuition fee for the 2024-2025 academic year. The scholarship is disbursed directly to the university at which the student is enrolled to cover tuition fees.

Scholarships will be awarded based on the strength of each candidate's contributions to diversity, demonstrated leadership, and academic background.

The program is open to eligible students who meet all the minimum qualifications.

Who can apply?

To be eligible to apply, applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited university for the 2024-2025 academic year
- Be studying at the University of Pavia, Italy
- Be studying Engineering (Automation, Robotics, Electronics, Mechatronics, Photonics), Telecommunication/IC, or a closely related technical field
- Demonstrate a strong academic record
- Exemplify leadership and demonstrate a passion for improving representation of underrepresented groups in computer science and technology
- Have a sufficient proficiency in English to understand and communicate.

NOTE: This scholarship is only for the 2024-2025 academic year. In cases where a candidate already possesses a scholarship or does not have to pay tuition fees, a certificate of recognition will be provided instead. The scholarship amount is directly given to the university where the student is enrolled, to cover the tuition fee.

Application process

The application process includes the completion of an online application form. This will involve:

- Providing general background information (e.g., contact information and details about your academic achievements)
- Submitting academic transcripts from your current and any prior institutions (if you have earned a previous degree)
- Responding to questions related to your motivation, innovative mindset, leadership skills, and community engagement
- Participating in a 15–20-minute interview if shortlisted.
